


Tom and Marilyn Holleron Volunteer Service Scholarship



Tom and Marilyn Holleron were faithful members of Johnson Memorial United Methodist Church for nearly 30 years. They had hearts for volunteering within the church and far beyond their parish activities. Their lives were marked by generosity not only with financial resources but with the altruistic giving of themselves to groups and programs organized to impact the lives of others. The value and importance of education was also an important element to the beliefs of Tom and Marilyn. The Tom and Marilyn Holleron Volunteer Service Scholarship Trust was created with memorial contributions from family and friends to support an individual from the Huntington tri-state area, who is active in volunteering and enrolled in a post-secondary education program. In a statement guiding the Trust Fund, Lorri Stepp and Jeanne Elam, daughters of Tom and Marilyn said, "Having a memorial scholarship that will be given to an individual who can understand the selflessness of giving to other through

volunteering is a way we wish to honor our parents' memory...so that their legacy of volunteering will be promoted and encouraged in others."

Application Requirements

Personal Information: Please submit a letter of application that includes the following personal data:

- Name
- Address
- Phone
- E-mail address
- Educational background (high school attended, graduation date, college attending, major, expected graduation date).

References: Submit two letters of reference, one of which must be from a responsible person with the organization for which the applicant has served as a volunteer and who can evaluate the volunteer's efforts. Letters of reference should be sent directly to the church e-mail address listed herein. Referring persons may send copies to the applicant if they wish.

Essay: Write an essay, not to exceed 500 words, that includes the importance of voluntary service, how volunteering has affected your life as well as the lives of those served by your work.

Photo: Please include a recent photo

Application Submission Please submit the application by the end of the day Friday, March 31, to the senior pastor of Johnson Memorial United Methodist Church by way of an attachment to an e-mail to johnsonmumc@gmail.com; please mark the subject line "Holleron Scholarship". Your application should contain the personal data, your essay, and the photo. Ask references to send letters directly to this e-mail address. Announcement of the scholarship award will be made by the end of April.
